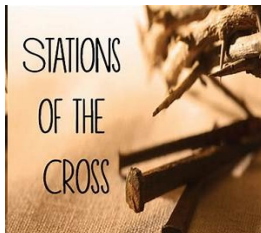

A holy time to prepare to hear words of grace and faith at Mass the following Sunday. Refreshments available.



## “Jesus Manifested His Glory and His Disciples Believed in Him” (John 2:11)

### Jesus’ Relationship with His Disciples and Others in the Gospel Stories

Our understanding and love of Jesus can be deepened by examining those touched by his life. This course considers individuals and groups affected by Jesus and their responses to him. . **Sessions will be held in the Cupertino Center at St. Casimir Church from 7 to 8:30 PM, on Wednesdays starting February 21st.**

**Session I:** “That They Might Be with Him,,,” (Mark 3:14) The place and role of Jesus’ twelve disciples. Our own relationship with Jesus. Focus on Mark’s gospel.

**Session II:** “And Peter said, ‘Lord, It Is Good for Us to Be Here...’” (Matthew 17:4) Peter, James, and John: their closeness with Jesus. Our own drawing close to Jesus. Focus on Matthew’s gospel.

**Session III:** “And Many Other Women Provided for Them out of Their Means.” (Luke 8:3). The presence and prominence of women in the story of Jesus. Insight for our times. Focus on Luke and John.

**Session IV:** “However the Man Cured of Leprosy Went and Proclaimed It Freely.” (Mark 1:44) Those who encountered Jesus respond in different ways. Our own responses. Focus on Matthew’s gospel.

**Session V:** “They Sent to Him Some of the Pharisees and the Herodians to Catch Him.” (Mark 12:13) Some in Jesus’ world rejected him -- even to the point of plotting his death. Focus on Luke and John.



**Holy Week is the most special of all weeks. It begins with Passion (Palm) Sunday and includes the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection). Holy Week should be celebrated as one, rather than a series of celebrations.**

**PASSION (PALM) SUNDAY, MARCH 25, 2018**

Palms will be blessed and distributed at each of our Regularly Scheduled Masses.  
There will be **NO** Confessions on Saturday, March 24th.

**MASS OF CHRISM, MONDAY, MARCH 26, 2018**

Mass of Chrism will be held at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen at 7:30 PM.  
The Sacred Oils will be blessed and consecrated for use in the Archdiocese, and the priests, deacons, religious, and all those in pastoral ministry of the Church of Baltimore will renew their commitment to service. All are Welcome.

Mass will be celebrated at 8:00 AM each day in St. Casimir Church.



**HOLY THURSDAY, MARCH 29, 2018**

At **St. Casimir Church**, the **Celebration of the Lord's Supper** will be held at **7:00 PM**. During our celebration we commemorate the Last Supper when Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Eucharist and the commandment to serve one another, which was portrayed by the washing of the feet. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** will take place until **10:00 PM** and will conclude with the Night Prayer in the Cupertino Chapel. We ask that a spirit of prayerful silence be observed while in the Chapel & foyer. At **St. Elizabeth's Church**, the celebration of the Last Supper will be held at 7:00 PM

**GOOD FRIDAY, MARCH 30, 2018**

At **12:00 PM**, **St. Casimir, St. Brigid & St. Elizabeth** will be open to pray the *Stations of the Cross*.

*Celebration of the Lord's Passion* will be held at **3:00 PM** at **St. Casimir & St. Elizabeth. Chapel will be open from 4:30 PM to 9:00 PM for private prayer at St. Casimir Church.**

**HOLY SATURDAY, MARCH 31, 2018**

**Morning Prayer and Office of Readings** will be held at **8:00 AM** at the Church.  
We will also anoint our Catechumens who will be **Baptized** at the **Easter Vigil**. The traditional **blessing of Easter Food** will take place at **12:00 Noon** at **St. Casimir Church** and will remain open for a short time following the blessing for those who wish to make a visit.
