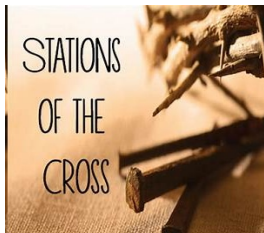

SELDOM READ BOOKS OF THE CHRISTIAN SCRIPTURES

Our Lenten Bible study will examine books in Christian scripture not familiar to many Christians and will consider the letters of 1 & 2 Peter, of James, of Jude, of John, and to the Hebrews as well as the book of Revelation. Sessions will be held on Wednesdays from March 13 to April 10 from 7 to 8:30 pm.

March 13: "Submit yourselves therefore to God." (James 4:7) The letters of James and Jude

March 20: "Come to him, that living stone..." (1 Peter 2:4) The two letters of Peter

March 27: "For the word of God is living and active..." (Hebrews 4:12) The letter to the Hebrews

April 3: "Who is the liar but he who denies Jesus is the Christ?" (1 John 2:22) The three letters of John

April 10: "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth..." (Revelation 21:1) The book of Revelation



Holy Week is the most special of all weeks. It begins with Passion (Palm) Sunday and includes the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection). Holy Week should be celebrated as one, rather than a series of celebrations.

PASSION (PALM) SUNDAY, APRIL 14, 2019

Palms will be blessed and distributed at each of our Regularly Scheduled Masses. There will be *NO* Confessions on Saturday, April 13th.

MASS OF CHRISM, MONDAY, APRIL 15, 2019

Mass of Chrism will be held at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen at 7:30 PM. The Sacred Oils will be blessed and consecrated for use in the Archdiocese, and the priests, deacons, religious, and all those in pastoral ministry of the Church of Baltimore will renew their commitment to service. Mass will be celebrated at 8:00 AM each day in the Church at St. Casimir Church and St. Elizabeth Church.

HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 18, 2019



The **Celebration of the Lord's Supper** will be held at **7:00 PM** in the church. During our celebration we commemorate the Last Supper when Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Eucharist and the commandment to serve one another, which was portrayed by the washing of the feet. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** will take place until **10:00 PM** and will conclude with the Night Prayer in the Cupertino Chapel. We ask that a spirit of prayerful silence be observed while in the Chapel & foyer.

The Church will open at **12:00 PM** to pray the *Stations of the Cross*.
Celebration of the Lord's Passion will be held at **3:00 PM**.
Chapel will be open from 4:30 PM to 9:00 PM for private prayer.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 20, 2019

Morning Prayer and Office of Readings will be held at 8:00 AM in the Church.

We will also anoint our Catechumens who will be Baptized at the Easter Vigil

The traditional **blessing of Easter Food** will take place at **12:00 Noon** in the Church. St. Casimir Church will remain open for a short time following the blessing for those who wish to make a visit.

Easter Vigil will be celebrated at **8:00 PM** in the Church.
