During our celebration we commemorate the Last Supper when Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Eucharist and the commandment to serve one another, which was portrayed by the washing of the feet. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** will take place until **9:00 PM** and will conclude with the Night Prayer in the Chapel. We ask that a spirit of prayerful silence be observed while in the Chapel.

GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 15

At **12:00 PM** we will pray the *Stations of the Cross* at St. Casimir Church.

Celebration of the Lord's Passion will be held at **3:00 PM** at St. Casimir Church.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 16

The traditional **blessing of Easter Food** will take place at **12:00 Noon** in St. Casimir Church and remain open for a short time following the blessing for those who wish to make a visit.

There will be **NO** Confessions on Saturday, April 16th.

Easter Vigil will be celebrated at **8:00 PM**.
